NWDA Parent Portal

We know how challenging adjusting to a new schedule can be but, don't worry, we've got your back! The NWDA Parent Portal is a great tool to help you keep track of your dancer's classes and schedule and can be found under the Register menu on our website.

Most of you already know that our Parent Portal can be used to update contact and billing info as well as sign up for classes, but it also has a handy feature that allows you to view and print your dancer's schedule under the My Classes tab. Have multiple dancers in the family? No problem! There's a drop down menu in the left hand corner that lets you switch between students to view each dancer's individual schedule or you may choose All to view all classes your dancers are enrolled in. For optimal viewing, we suggest clicking on the Days column heading in order to sort classes by day of the week. The program will sort the days of the week alphabetically, not chronologically, but this will group classes that take place on the same day together. You can then print these schedules for easy access and post on the refrigerator, message board, or locker of your choice!

We hope this info will come in handy and we also hope that you will find time to explore all of the fantastic features our Parent Portal has to offer!
