
## Parent Portal

## New Features

There have also been several upgrades around the studio that we're pleased to share! We have created a more functional study area for students in the back hall with plenty of table space and seats, perfect for those days when your dancer may have time between classes. We also have opened up a small kitchenette area with microwave, refrigerator, and sink for snack and meal times. If you've wondered what's behind that black curtain in the back hall, that's our new three-stall changing area which will allow more room for quick outfit changes and free up the restrooms in between classes. A projector and screen have been installed in Studio 1 so students can take online lessons and practice learning new choreography on a regular basis, an aditional stretching rack has been built in Studio 2 to aid students in improving flexibility and core strength, and Studio 4 has new ambient lighting which will help set the mood for more relaxed freestyling and practice. We have also added two new television monitors in the lobby and hallway which will display important reminders and information throughout the year.

With some of these new features comes responsibility and we ask that, for the benefit of all, people pick up after themselves. Please talk to your students about this so that we can all fully enjoy these new conveniences and keep the studio looking great!

# Viewing Windows

We would also like to point out that the studio viewing windows have been equipped with blinds to be used at the discretion of the teachers. We know this may be disappointing to parents who look forward to watching classes but it can greatly increase student focus by limiting the distractions during class as well as relieve some of the self consciousness that may come with being observed while exploring new movements. While they may not be used every week, we appreciate your understanding when they are in use and hope that you know it is your dancers' best interest that we have in mind.
